

Current State Oakhurst

Our community: Oakhurst is a rural foothill community near Yosemite National Park in Madera County. The OUD population is significant for a community of 3,000 there is no emergency department in the community and there are various organizations providing outpatient behavioral health services including our clinic.

Current State Assessment Oakhurst

- We used the following methods to learn more about our current state: Spoke to staff, used the assessment which helped put into perspective where we are
- We spoke to:
 - Staff: Would like more information and worried on how much extra time it will take
 - Patients: Not well informed or understand fully the MAT process
- From providers and staff we learned: lack of knowledge and challenges adapting to change
- From patients we learned: Transportation is a big factor and apprehensive
- Other insights we gathered from current state activities: Need to establish protocols as more providers and staff are trained regarding MAT
- We received the following feedback on the appropriateness and acceptability of using MAT in our clinic: mixed reaction on appropriateness and questions on amount of time it will take

Our Team Has Been Wondering . . .

- Our questions to other teams: What has worked best in increasing buy in from patients and support staff.
- Our questions for faculty: Examples of models of policies and best practices.
- We need support to accomplish: How to improve engagement and increasing Waiver X trained providers.
