Our community: LCH service area is comprised of many low-income rural communities.


Two hospitals: Mercy Medical Center Merced) and Emmanuel Medical Center.

- Outpt office-based, home inductions, recent injectable
- 2 + of waivered providers
- 18 of patients receiving MAT in the previous 6 months

Goals for ATSH participation:

- Increase # pt served

Capability Assessment: What We Learned

- In completing the assessment, we were surprised by:
 - Nada! it highlighted our weaknesses,
 - We need more communication, coordination
- Our team's areas of strength:
 - Unified, one goal, we are all on the same page to help increase patient's functioning and QOL
- Areas for development:
 - Tell us what we are doing wrong!
 - Incorporating random strip, pill counts
 - Support from nursing staff, how to develop this role



Current State Assessment

- We used the following methods to learn more about our current state:
 - We talked to each other, given differences in schedules this does not happen as often as we would like
- We spoke to:
 - MAT staff, support staff, administration
 - Patients: not yet
- From providers and staff we learned:
 - We need to talk more
- Other insights we gathered from current state activities:
 - Highlights what we knew but didn't have to words to describe

 - Clinical questions with specific patients (e.g. pregnant patients, coordination w OB/Gyn)

 - suboxone vs sublocade
 - naltrexone: what type of presentation would you recommend
