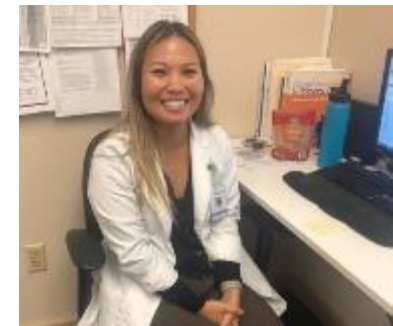

Current State [site level]



- **Our community: 99% Hispanic urban community in Bell Gardens, Maywood, Hawaiian Gardens and Downey, some of whom have alcohol abuse disorder. With a relationship with Volunteers of America Behavioral Health Services**
- **Current state:**
 - **Short description of our MAT program: We had just started treating alcohol abuse with Vivitrol. Have not started with Buprenorphine**
 - **Capacity: 2** waived providers
 - **Patient population: 2** patients received MAT in the previous 6 months
- **Goals for ATSH participation: To be able to help alleviate the opioid crisis by making treatment more accessible to patients.**

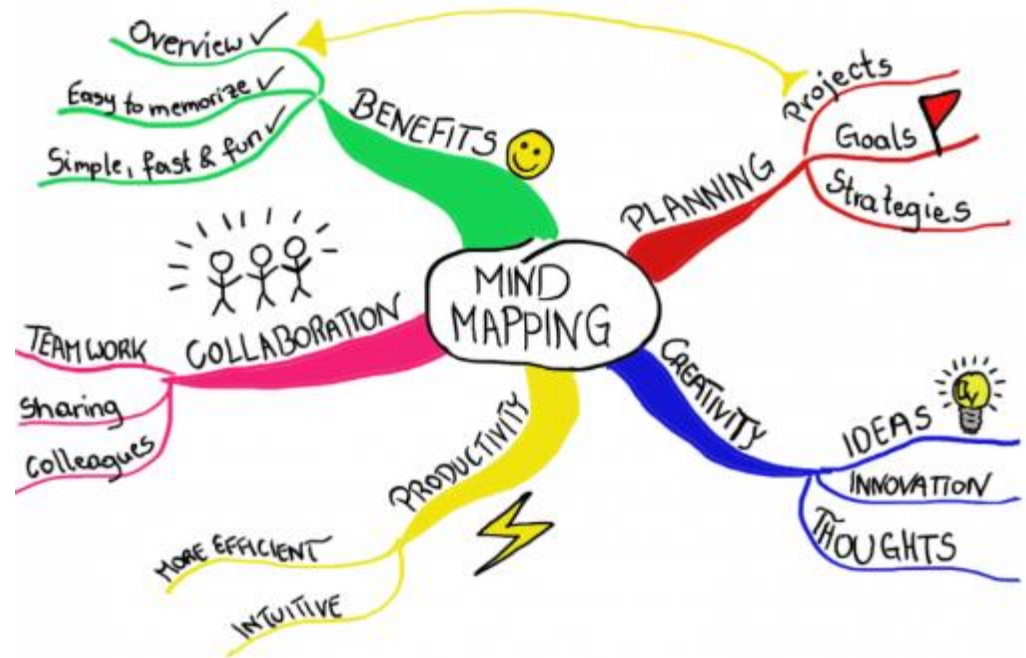
Capability Assessment: What We Learned

Current State Assessment

- We used the following methods to learn more about our current state:
- We spoke to:
 - Executive Team
 - Clinic Managers
 - Providers/Medical Assistant Leads
 - Operations Team
 - Outreach Team
- From providers and staff we learned:
 - There may be some attitudinal barriers
 - Behavioral Health services needs to be more Integrated
 - Outreach and community networking needed for referrals
- From patients we learned: There is willingness to change
- Other insights we gathered from current state activities: THAT WE NEED A LOT OF HELP
