### Contingency Management Question:

Joe was coming to your clinic for MAT program on Suboxone and complying but struggling on Tier 2. You eventually sent Joe to a local residential called Freedom Center, for 30 days on October 1st. That program took over the Suboxone Rx from us until he was released in 30 days at which point, he would come back to the clinic November 1st. The freedom center gave Joe 2 weeks (14 days) worth of suboxone 3 strips a day for a total of 42 strips, Joe started using heroin and did not use all his strips for almost a month. Joe got COVID and ended up in a COVID hotel with no contact with our clinic. Joe started his suboxone again while in hotel and was released to the streets on December 1<sup>st</sup> with enough suboxone that he had left over to get to 12/16/21. Joe got a hold of his family in Idaho, and they sent him a greyhound ticket and guaranteed him a place to live. They said they would help him and its better then being on the streets in Santa Cruz with no help. Joe left and moved in with his family in Idaho on 12/6/21. Joe went to every clinic and place he could find in Idaho and was told he could not get an appointment to continue Suboxone till the end of January or February. Joe knows he is going to run out and does not want to go back to using so he calls you to see if there is a way you can help him out.
