Brian Hurley, MD, MBA, DFASAM is an addiction physician and general psychiatrist at the Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health. Brian is currently the Treasurer of the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) and gives presentations around the world related to addiction medicine. He is the Clinical Director for the second iteration of the Treating Addiction in the Primary Care Safety Net Program funded by the California Health Care Foundation, and is a primary investigator on a Tobacco Related Disease Prevention Program-funded project integrating smoking cessation services into community mental health centers and patient-centered medical homes. He additionally serves on the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology's Addiction Psychiatry examination writing committee. Brian completed the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Clinical Scholars Program at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) and is an alumnus of the Massachusetts General Hospital and McLean Hospital psychiatry residency training program and the New York University addiction psychiatry fellowship. He has additionally served in various roles for the Massachusetts Society of Addiction Medicine, New York Society of Addiction Medicine, and California Society of Addiction Medicine.
