Current State: ACEs Screening & Response

- Our current strengths:
 - As the first PCMH clinic in California to be recognized by NCQA for the integration of Medical and Behavioral Health Services, we have a strong integrated team that is patient centered, therefore we strive to always consider the patient perspective when providing care.
 - We currently provide TIC training for staff for recognizing, understanding and responding to patient trauma
 - Our ACES form is set up as an eCW SMART form, and all providers are aware that ACES should be completed with all patients.
