# High-level Q4 clinical data summary

1. On average, CALQIC organizations increased the proportion of PCPs trained and eligible to bill for ACEs screening: from **46%** in Q3 to **61%** in Q4.
2. Nearly half (7/15) of CALQIC organizations were conducting pediatric ACEs screening in Q4 2020. Three were conducting adult ACEs screening.
3. Most CALQIC organizations reporting Q4 2020 screening data indicated that **fewer than 25% of pediatric patients** and **over 40% of adult patients** screened for ACEs are at high risk of ACE-related health conditions (i.e., reported 4 or more ACEs).
4. CALQIC organizations reporting response data indicated pediatric and adult patients received a response most, if not all, of the time in Q4 2020.
