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NEXT STEPS INTERVIEWS

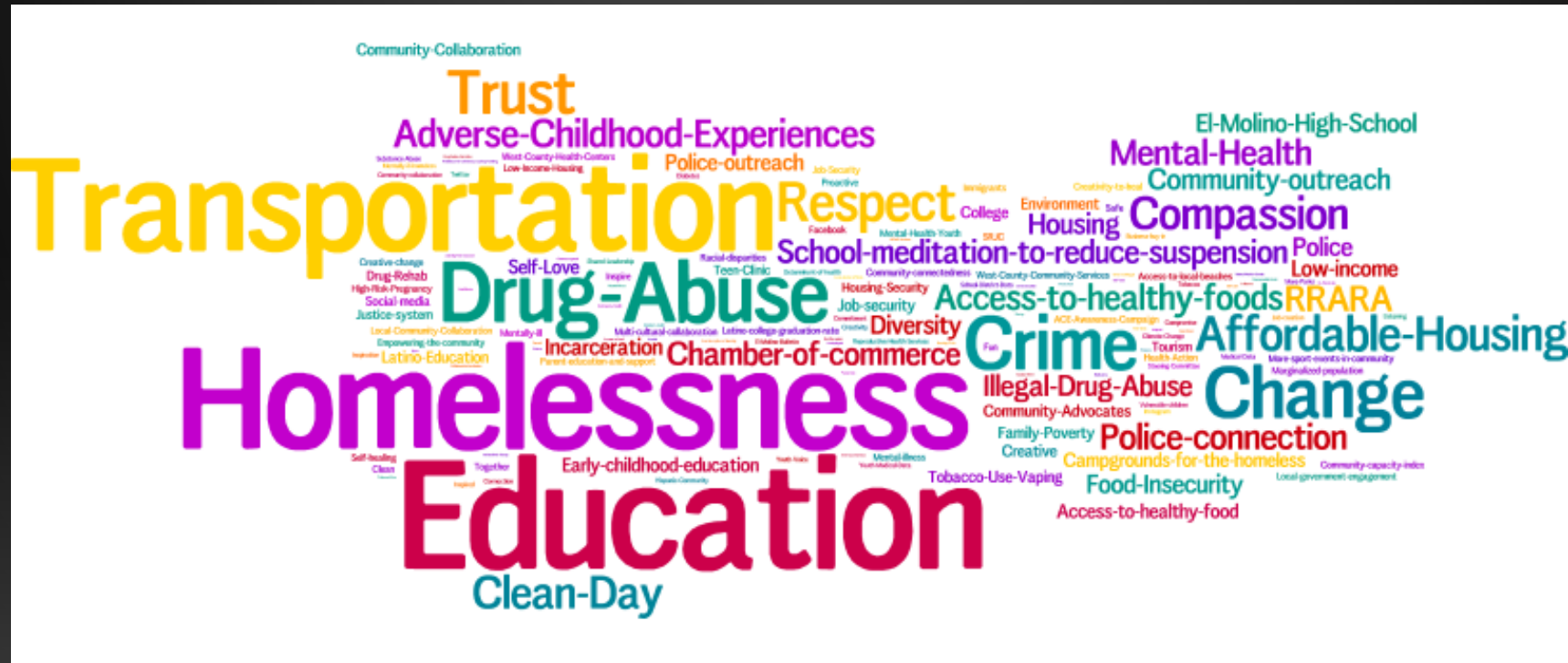
A **one hour follow up interview** is scheduled in the environment that is comfortable and familiar to the stakeholder.

During this interview a team of three (**An Interviewer, A Video Recorder & Scribe**) help ensure the intended data was properly captured.



NEXT STEPS WORD CLOUD

An image composed of all of the interviewees words highlighted important textual data points that visually conveyed information that was valuable to all of the interviewees.

CODING

Digging Deeper

- Uncover the storyline that the interviewees shared
 - To help this narrative we decided to Code the Qualitative Data
 - Coding each interview allowed us to organize, synthesize and interpret what is happening in the data

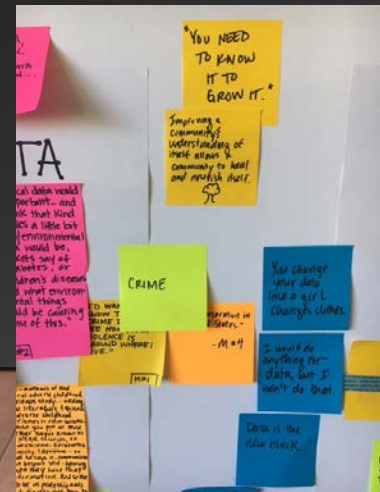
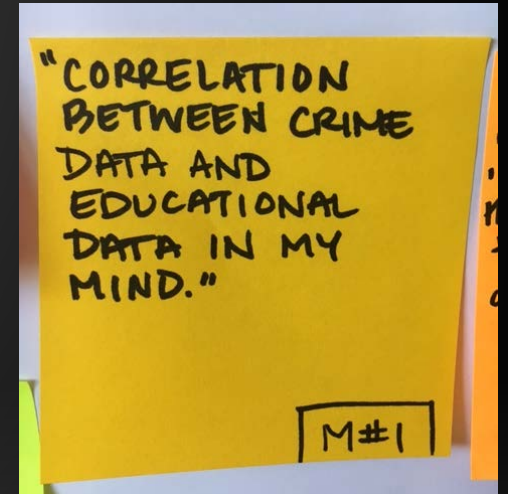
