Assessment and Stratification

High Risk

- Intake Interview & Assessment which includes the Patient Health Questionnaire (PHQ9) for depression, and the Generalized Anxiety Disorder Assessment (GAD7)
- Referrals & Linkage

- Intake Interview & Assessment
- Referrals & Linkage

Low Risk

- Resources
- Referrals & Linkage
