Venice Family Clinic Overview

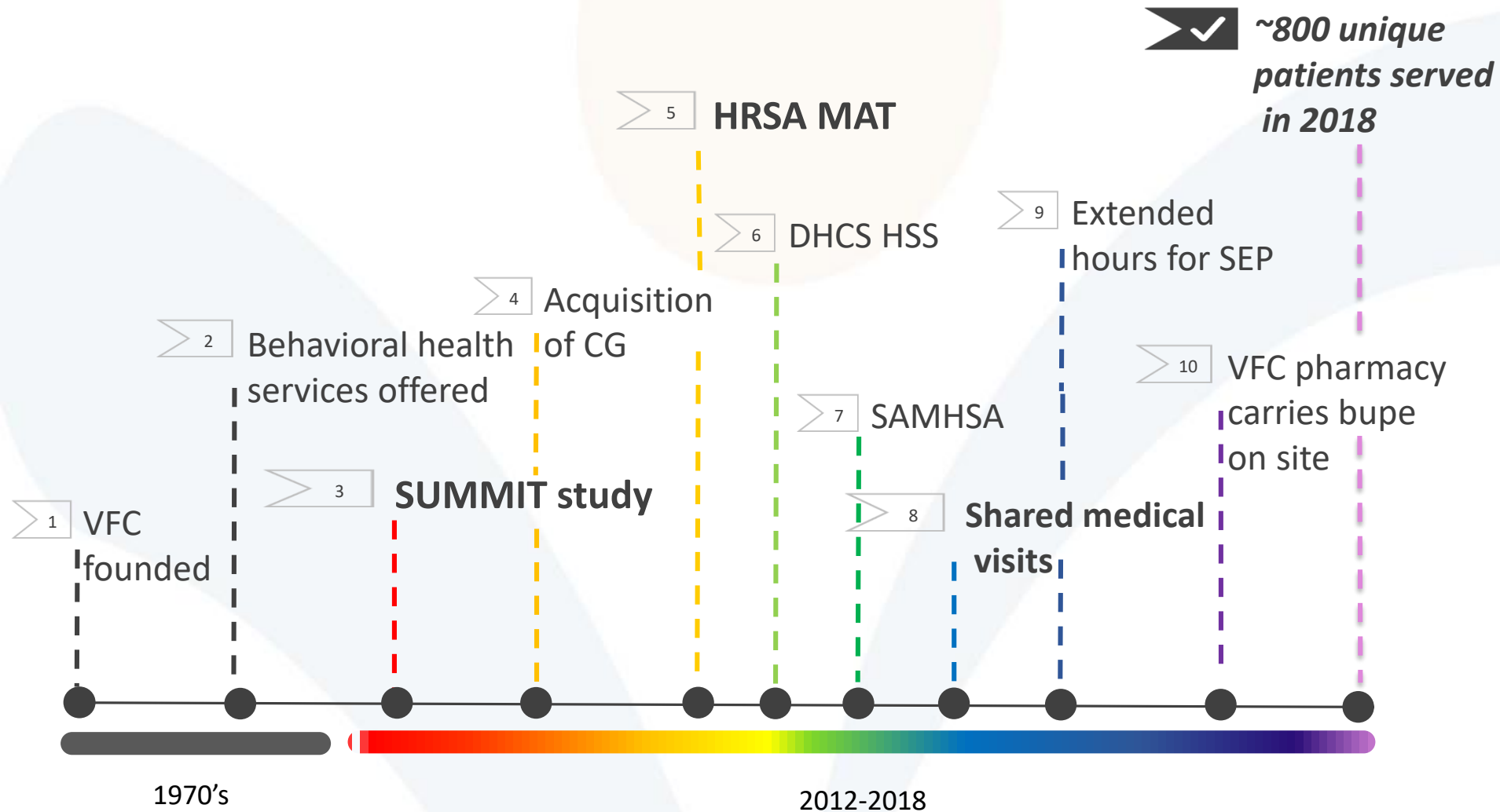
Our Mission:

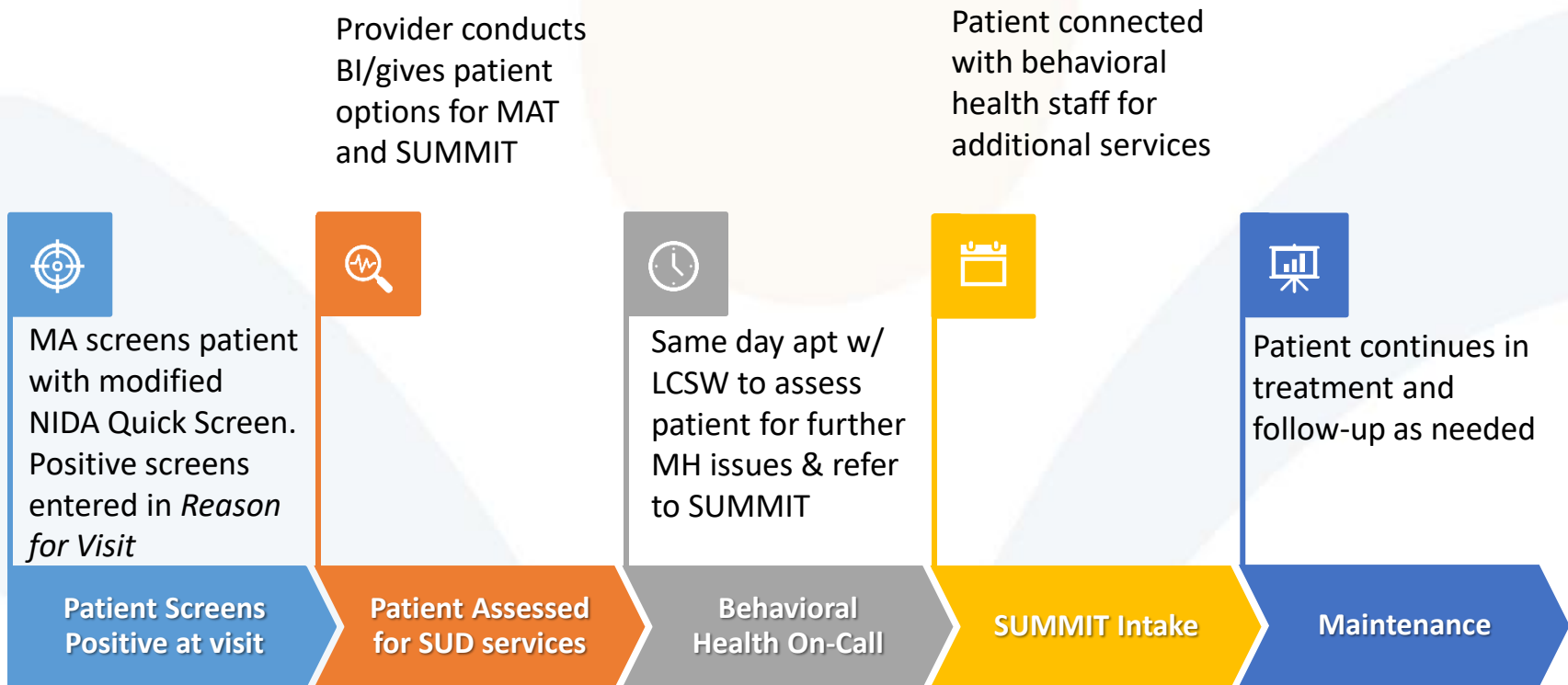

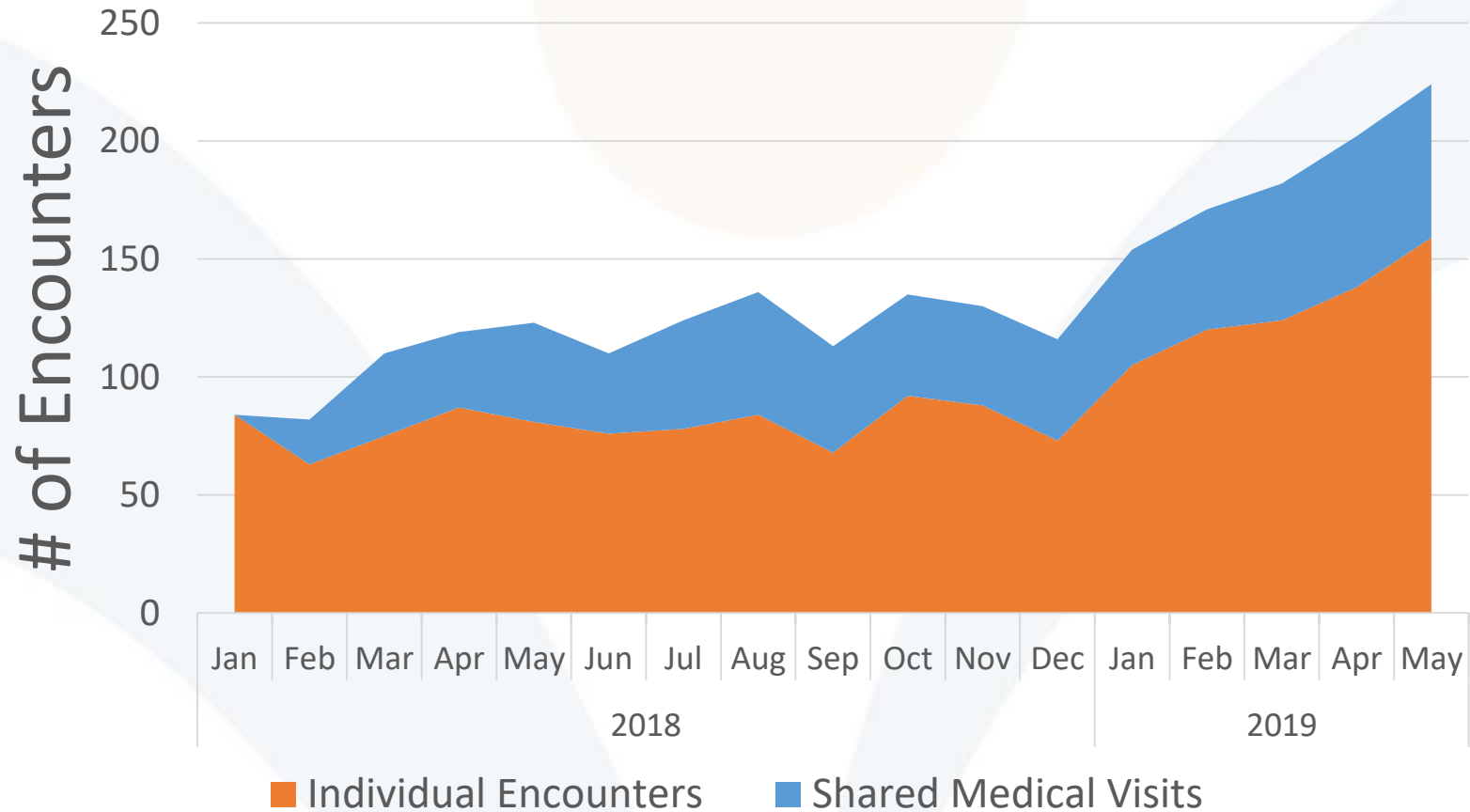
