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<p>Medical – MD, NP, PA</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Waivered Provider for Buprenorphine Rx2. Ongoing Buprenorphine care through phases3. Primary Care4. Urine Drug Screening for Safety/stability	<p>Behavioral Health - Licensed</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Complete Biopsychosocial Assessment or update (if seen before) includes additional screening, BH diagnoses and referrals for medication eval with PCP or Psychiatry.2. Psychiatry as needed3. Therapy as needed for patient4. Early stabilization can be skills based5. BH can include MAT Group facilitation
<p>Recovery Care – Certification</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Individual counseling per Recovery Treatment Plan2. MAT Recovery Group, as assigned3. Placement in community SUD care, i.e., Residential, Outpatient, Intensive Outpatient4. Management of Native Cultural Recovery Needs, if Native5. Provide access to Red Road and Wellbriety care	<p>Case Management/Network of Care</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Manages MAT weekly case reviews2. Mat Care coordination – internal<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Medical• Pharmacy• BH• Recovery Needs including assessing for Level of care• Dental3.
