

MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT) PHASES OF CARE

SUD Intake – This is where the patient meets with an SUD counselor to complete all intake paperwork and assessments.

Case Conference- This is a weekly meeting with all of MAT providers, counselors, therapists, care-coordinators, and staff to discuss new intakes and any concerns or issues with our current patients.

Physical/Home Induction – After SUD intake and case conference, the patient is scheduled with a MAT provider for a physical/home induction.

Induction 2 (Follow-up) – Usually set within 3 days of induction appointment to see how the patient is doing with their medications.

2x (Week) – if a patient is in need of more frequent visits, he/she is scheduled to come in twice a week.

Weekly (Group) – This is our weekly MAT refill group, patients are scheduled to group after their induction 2 appointment.

Bi-Weekly – Once a patient has given 4 consecutive negative UA's for opiates and benzo's they will be moved to bi-weekly (every two weeks).

Monthly – Again, once a patient has 4 consecutive negative UA's for opiates and benzo's they will be moved to monthly (once a month).

Bi-Monthly – Once a patient give 3 consecutive negative UA's for opiates and benzo's they will be moved to bi-monthly (once every two months).

In order for a patient to advance to the next phase of treatment, he/she must produce 4 negative UA's in a row. Except for our monthly's, which is 3 consecutive negative UA's for opiates and benzos.
