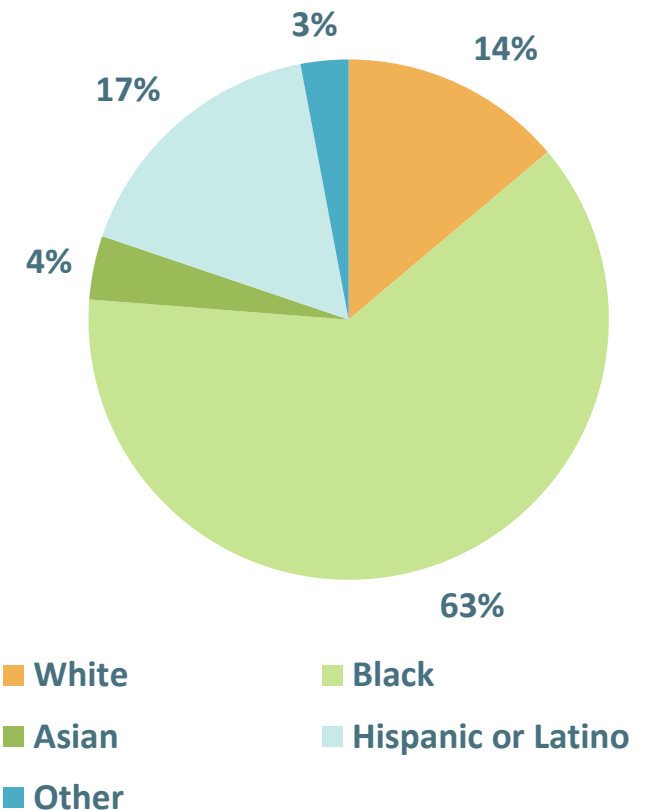


Prince George's County Demographics

 - \$79,184



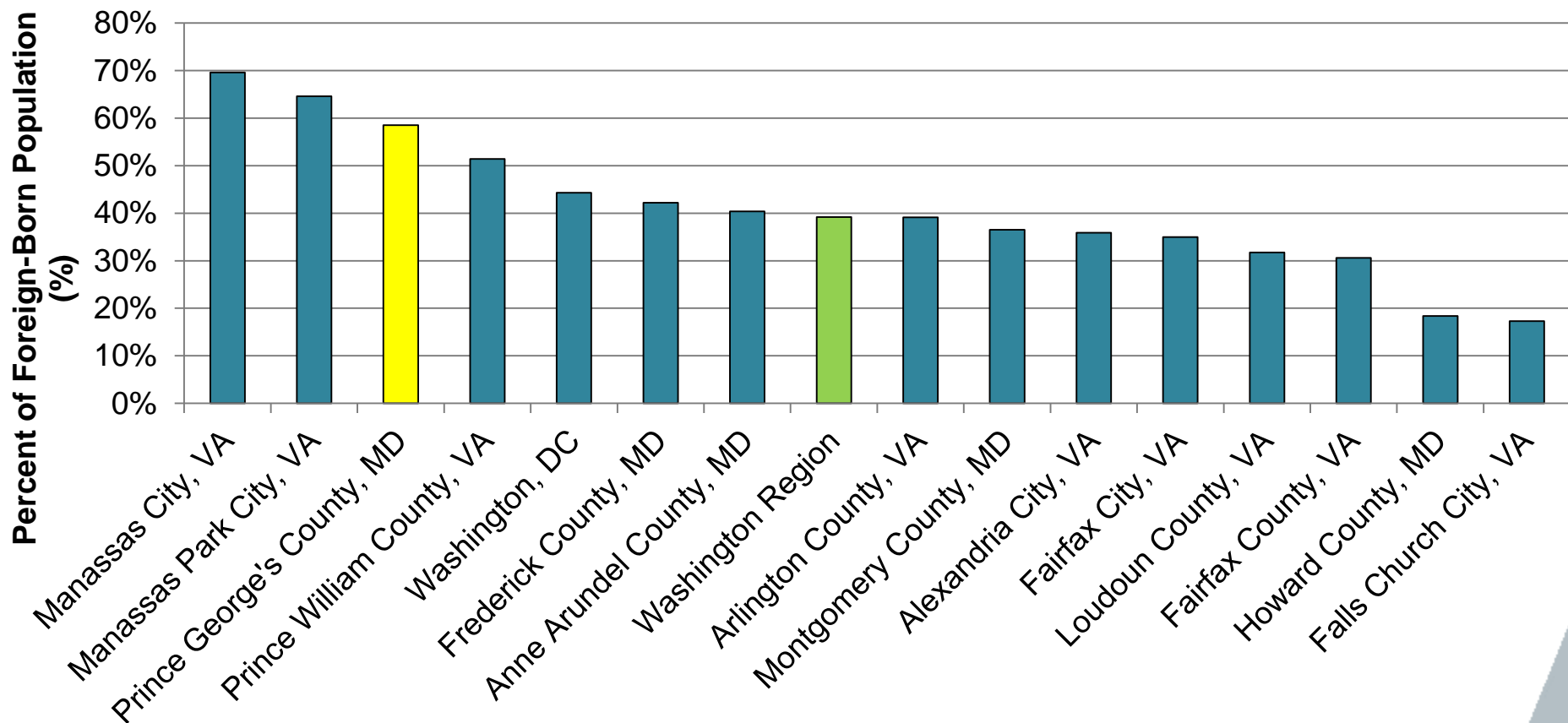
Over ¾'s of the Region's Immigrants Lived in Fairfax, Montgomery and Prince George's County

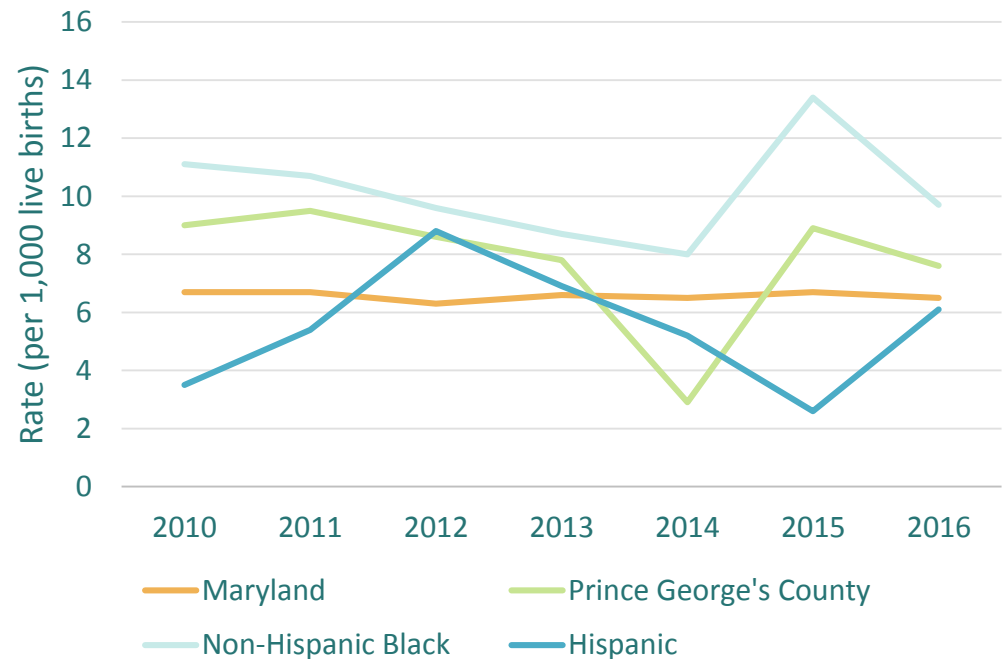

Infant Mortality in Prince George's County

- The death rate for black infants in Prince George's County is higher than Maryland's rate of 6.3.
- The death rate among Hispanic infants tripled from 2015 to 2016.

Infant Mortality in Prince George's County by Race and Hispanic Origin

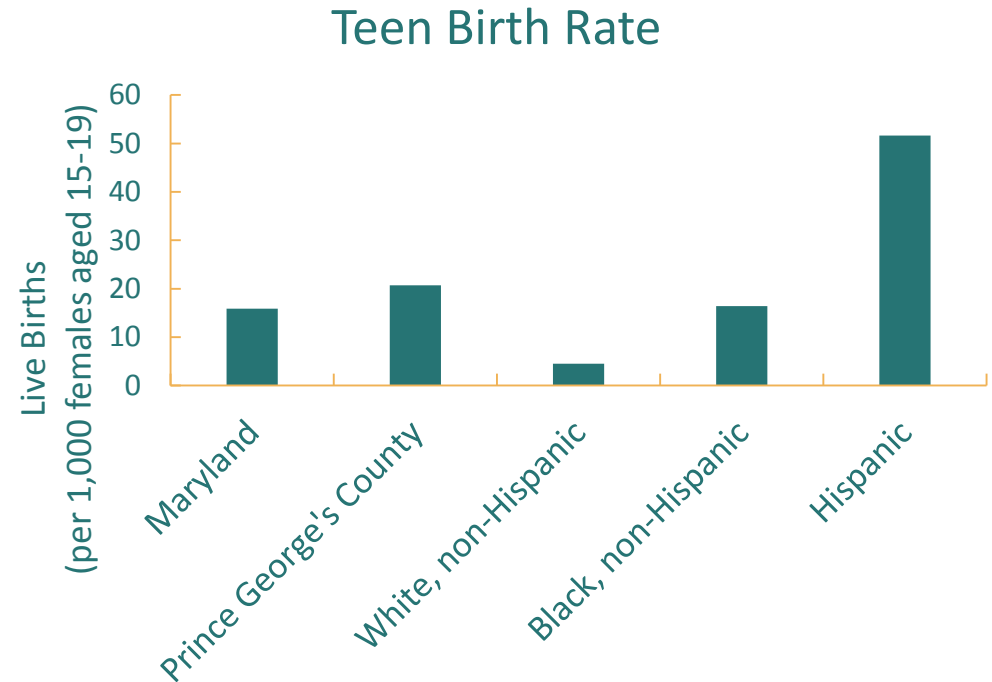

Teen Births in Prince George's County

- The birth rate to teens aged 15-19 is higher than Maryland's rate.
- The birth rate for Hispanic teens is more than 11 times higher than the rate for white teens and 3 times that of black teens.
- The birth rate for black teens is nearly 4 times higher than the birth rate for white teens.
