We acknowledge the critical need for reflection, inquiry and prioritization of the most critical needs.



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### Why use the 7-part pitch structure?



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
# 7 Part Structure for Communicating for Change

- A story: A vision for a better future
- The challenge or problem

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

- 3 Your work: how you looked into the challenge
  - A plan for change: 3 or 4 points
- 5 **Benefits** of succeeding with the plan
- 6 **Consequences** for failing to act
  - An ask: a specific call for support or action
