The Necessary Growing Pains of a High Functioning Team



Understanding Roles

- Clear understanding of everyone's scope of practice
- Shared patient care spaces
- Shared power and decision making
- Learn to dance with your team mates



Challenges

- Current system is not team-based or well integrated
- Reimbursement doesn't support team care



Clarity of Vision

- Everyone on the Team has shared vision.
- Vision drives patient care (ex. Patient First)
- Challenges to defining clinic purpose and referral criteria without clarity.



Challenges

- Individuals on team may not share vision
- Vision of the team may not be shared by community, funders, administration/c-suite



Identify up to 3 things any team member can do to help:

- Share patient care
- Identify/solidify shared vision
- Clarify roles
